Qualifications:

- 1. The applicant must be currently attending or accepted to an accredited college, university, or trade/vocational school for the 2023-2024 academic year. The applicant must be seeking an undergraduate degree if they are not attending a trade/vocational school.
- 2. The applicant must be related to a SCCJEU member (active, associate, or retired member of SCCJEU) in one of the following ways: son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter (includes step and/or legally adopted). The qualifying SCCJEU member must be named.
- 3. The applicants' overall grade point average must be 3.0 or higher.

Essay Questions:

Prepare an original essay of 500-1000 words on one (1) of the following topics.

- 1) What is your current/planned field of study? What or who inspired you to choose this field of study? What do you plan to do what this knowledge you learn?
- 2) Discuss a community service project you have participated in and the impact it had on the community. Is it something that you would do again why or why not.

 - 1. 1" Margins
 - 2. Typed in Ariel or Times New Roman 12 pt. font.
 - 3. Spacing should be 1.5; printed single sided.
 - 4. Header <center> SCCJEU Mary Zenor Memorial Scholarship Fund 2023
 - 5. Footer <left> Applicants Name; <right> page/pages/word count

Application Requirements:

- 1. Complete application (may be handwritten).
- 2. Letter of recommendation from a current or former instructor.
- 3. Resubmission of prior years' essay will be disqualified.
- 4. Essay 500-1000 words responding to one of the questions listed.
- 5. Current Transcript (may be unofficial; must contain your overall grade point average)
